

## OHVers! PROTECT YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO RIDE!

To protect your opportunity to use off-highway vehicles on the Rattlesnake Road (Forest Service Road) and connecting roads in the area, OHVers must follow the below listed, among other, common sense rules:

- Stay to the right side of the road when coming around blind corners. Groups must fall back into a single file line on the right side of the road when visibility is limited.
- Limit your speed to what is safe given the conditions. All traffic, including OHVs, need to follow the 15 mph speed limit on the roads. You will be responsible for any damage and injury you cause to others, if you are unable to stop or riding recklessly (CVC 38316 \$400 fine if no bodily injury, CVC 38317 mandatory court appearance in case of bodily injury, or civil law suit).
- Stay on the roads! For wildife's and everyone's sake, protect the environment (36CFR 26.15(h) \$250 fine or mandatory appearance in court).
- Be courteous to the people camping at Woodchuck Campground, Woodchuck
  4-H Camp by slowing down to under 15 mph when near these areas to minimize dust (CVC 38305 \$150 fine).
- ATVers wear your helmet (CVC 38505 \$100 fine). Do not carry passengers on ATVs not designed for two persons (CVC 38506 \$150 fine).
- Parents Be responsible for the safety and well being of your children. Make sure your children ride responsibly, if under 18 have taken a ATV safety coarse (CVC 38503 \$150 fine), and if under 14, be accompanied by an adult with a ATV safety certificate (CVC 38504 \$150 fine).

There have been too many serious accidents involving OHVs in this area, resource damage, and the Forest Service has received numerous complaints about reckless OHVers.

IF OHVERS CAN NOT RIDE RESPONSIBLY IN THIS AREA, WE WILL HAVE NO OTHER RECOURSE BUT TO DISALLOW THE USE OF OHVS.
